New Business:

A. Reschedule of Lieutenant test:

Promotional test for Lieutenant was originally scheduled for Thursday, September 22, 2019, at 6:00 p.m. at the Northside Fire Station. Motion by Mardis, second by Jacks, to move the Lieutenant testing to September 26, 2019, at 6:00 p.m. at the Northside Fire Station.

Miscellaneous Items:

A. Agility Testing and Open Houses

John Moore spoke regarding the candidates who are currently on the list for hire and after 12 months will all be required to retake the agility test. After discussion, motion by consensus to retest the candidates. Once candidates pass the test their names will continue to be on the list, however, if they fail, they will be removed from the list. Discussion regarding the Agility testing for the current candidates on Saturday, July 27, 2019, stating that if one or more do not pass, they are to let them know that they would not continue to be on the list. Commissioners discussed adding to the Rules and Regulations that two Open Houses will be offered for the current applicants to come to the fire station and practice (run the course) before the scheduled agility test.

B. Change in Air Miles within the city limits

After discussion, Jayson Nicewarner will talk with the FOP President to talk about the air miles versus response times.

C. Schedule of next meeting

After discussion, by consensus, an email will be sent out by President Mardis to schedule the next meeting to set the new rules for the agility testing.


ADJOURNMENT: There being no further business, motion by Jacks, second by Mardis to adjourn.
