City to Businesses: Help Instill City Pride by Taking Empty Trash Bins off Streets

Some businesses have been found to leave their bins out all day.

MORGANTOWN – The City of Morgantown is working to improve the walkability and pride in the city and is addressing an ongoing problem that is easily remedied by community participation from downtown businesses.

City officials have been made aware of a continued problem of trash cans being left on the streets outside of businesses following trash pickup. Many downtown businesses open late in the day, and this leaves the bins outside of the businesses during regular work hours, causing pedestrians to have to see – and smell – last night's trash.

To alleviate this unsightly problem, The City of Morgantown is asking that businesses owners take their bins inside as early as possible following service the day trash is picked up, preferably by 10 a.m. – consistent with rules and regulations of city code. Doing this will help to make our streets easier to traverse and more aesthetically pleasing to our everyday residents and also those seeing Morgantown for the first time.
