Annual Airline Traffic Reported Up at Morgantown Airport

Reports show enplanement numbers the likes which haven't been seen since the mid-1990s.



MORGANTOWN – The numbers are in for the Morgantown Municipal Airport, and city officials say it's a reflection of the ongoing economic growth in Morgantown and Monongalia County.

“It was the best year for airline passenger activity at Morgantown Airport since sometime in the mid-1990's,” reported Airport Director Michael Clow. “Almost 66% more passengers flew through Morgantown in 2011 than in 2010.”

In 2011, 33,781 passengers traveled through the airport compared to 2010 when only 20,399 passengers did so. Clow reports this as a 65.6% increase.

“The increase in air travel is just an indicator of the growth in economic activity for the area,” commented City Manager Terrence Moore on hearing the news.

The Morgantown Municipal Airport is operated and maintained by the City of Morgantown. United Express offers three daily flights to Washington Dulles from where travelers can select flights to all parts of the world.
