Dear Mr. Mikorski:

On behalf of the City's Human Rights Commission I am forwarding to you copies of two resolutions which have been prepared and approved unanimously by the Commission.

One resolution relates to Employment and Housing Non-Discrimination and the other relates to Marriage Equality.

It is our request that these documents be forwarded to the City Council for discussion. It is our request that the Council take action to endorse each of the resolutions.

Following Council actions, the Human Rights Commission will ask that both documents be forwarded to members of our County Legislative Delegation to the State Legislature as well as to chairpersons of pertinent Legislative Committees.

We are not asking Council to claim universal community agreement on each issue. We are asking it to stand with Morgantown persons and others throughout our State who are seeking protection for themselves – their jobs, their homes, and their primary relationships - in West Virginia under the statutes of our U.S. Constitution.
