Early Voting for 2013 Municipal Election held April 16-27, 2013

Registered residents can come to City Hall to vote in the two weeks leading up to Election Day.

MORGANTOWN – The City of Morgantown is holding its Municipal Election on April 30, but residents don't have to wait to cast their vote.

April 16 through 20 and 22 through 27, City Clerk Linda Little will be in the City Hall Foyer between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. for Early Voting. It is held Monday through Saturday, and is closed as usual on Sundays.

Residents also have the option to register for Absentee Voting and have a ballot sent by mail to their home. The deadline to sign up for that is April 25, and must be postmarked by April 29.

Finally, Election Day will be held April 30. City Hall will not be open this day. The polls will be open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. at the following locations:
