WVU Homecoming Parade

The Morgantown Police Department will be altering traffic patterns on *Friday, October 18, 2013, for the West Virginia University Homecoming Parade* beginning at 5:30pm. The parade will begin at 6:30 pm, on High Street.

Parking will be restricted on High, Prospect and North High Streets beginning at 5:30 pm.

Traffic in the downtown area will be restricted during the parade. Traffic will be detoured from Willey Street onto Prospect Street then up Price Street to Fife Street and down North High Street, turning right onto Maiden Lane to College Avenue then back onto University Avenue. Officers will be at the intersections to assist with traffic. Any motorists wishing to avoid the detour may travel on College Avenue from Willey Street to University Avenue.

Traffic patterns will be returned to normal as soon as possible following the parade. Parade spectators are urged to arrive downtown early to allow ample time for parking.
