City Offers Reminders Regarding Recycling, Trash, & More

MORGANTOWN – As 2012 ends and the new year begins, City administration would like to offer a few reminders in regards to recycling, trash pickup, and a few other things.

Recycling & New Toters

The City of Morgantown and Republic Services continue to deliver toters this week, with 70% of all toters delivered. Residents will have plenty of time to receive them, as service to the new, large green toters will not begin until January 7, 2013. Until then, residents are asked to keep the green toters put away, back from the sidewalk. Regular weekly single-stream recycling efforts do continue through the holidays, and residents should continue to use their small blue bins for recycling pickup until Jan. 7.



If a resident has not yet received a toter, and it is evident that the neighborhood has had its delivery, email morgantownwv@republicservices.com or call 284-7505.

Trash Pickup

Allied Waste/Republic picks up trash on a daily basis in Morgantown. It will not be running on Christmas Day or New Year's Day. Because of this, Tuesday's trash will be picked up Wednesday, Wednesday's trash on Thursday, etc. Residents should adjust their schedule and set the trash out a day later, if their pickup days are Tuesday – Friday.
