WHEREAS, this agreement will allow the City and CPASS to partner to promote cycling education and fund the costs of these courses;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Morgantown that the City Manager is authorized to execute the attached agreement, together with any additional agreements referenced therein, which is incorporated in this Resolution by reference, to provide for bicycle education classes

Memorandum of Understanding

This is a Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Morgantown and West Virginia University College of Physical Activity and Sports Sciences (CPASS) for the delivery of PE 212 Confident City Cycling bicycling education classes. After CPASS delivers each class, CPASS will submit a bill to the City Manager for reimbursement of costs incurred in the delivery, which include instructor fees and class materials.

City of Morgantown funds for PE 212 Confident City Cycling are limited to \$4,200 at the date of signature of this memorandum. CPASS will not incur costs exceeding this amount. When CPASS recognizes that scheduling additional PE 212 classes will exceed this amount, CPASS will notify the City Manager. The City Manager and CPASS may then jointly decide to modify this memorandum or to terminate it.
