Priorities


People responding to the survey overwhelmingly want the City to find ways to improve paving of streets and maintenance of the streets.

Streets received 55.61% to be top priority, and 71.92% that streets are one of the top two priorities.

Crime prevention received 25.13% of the top priority and 58.29% of the top two priorities.


Q3 From the services listed below, please rank (1 is most important) them as you see the importance of the City service to grow to the new level of demand.

Q2 Which City Ward do you live in?



Demographics of responders


Q5 How long have you lived in Morgantown?
