Morgantown Tree Board Plans Tree Planting for Arbor Day 2016

MORGANTOWN – The Morgantown Tree Board has planned an event to span the city this year on Arbor Day celebrated Saturday, October 15 this year. Several members of the Tree Board and the community will gather at the Morgantown Marketplace, Farmers Market Pavilion on Spruce Street at 9:00 a.m.

One tree will be planted by a Tree Board representative and volunteers in each ward of the city.

“This is the 19th year that the City of Morgantown and the Morgantown Tree Board has celebrated Arbor Day,” said Marchetta Maupin, the Urban Landscape Director. “Autumn is a great time for planting. We encourage everyone to come out to sites in their ward at approximately 9:30 a.m. It’s a great opportunity to learn about planting trees.”

The sites that community members will plant White Dogwoods, (*Cornus florida*) are as follows:

- 6th Paul Preserve, Jerome Park
- 7th Indian Park, Collins Ferry & Aspen

The day will begin with a proclamation reading by a member of City Council at the Morgantown Marketplace at 9:00 a.m.
