Ordinance: [Zoning Reclassification, Parcel in Fourth Ward from B-1 to B-2](#) – Service Station Property at the “Suncrest Triangle,” corner of University & Collins Ferry.

Ordinance: [Zoning Reclassification, Parcels in Third and Fifth Wards from R-2 and B-2 to B-4](#) – Site of old “Central School”

Street and Alley Sign Replacement Program– Sign codes have changed, but there are ways to recycle and reuse parts from previous signs.

Downtown Food Vendors Plan– The City is looking to create guidelines for where and when street vendors can set up their stand.
