Board of Zoning Appeals – There is one opening on the Board of Zoning appeals.

The BZA consists of one council member and six volunteer members who serve for six year terms. Its mission is to uphold the integrity of the zoning ordinance while hearing and deciding upon applications for variances, conditional use permits, and administrative appeals with meaningful citizen input and technical support from the Morgantown Planning Department.
