

JOB ANNOUNCEMENT

The City of Morgantown is now accepting resumes for the position of a part-time, regular **Laborer** for the Morgantown Airport at \$14.26 per hour.

The incumbent ensures the safety, security and maintenance of Airport grounds, equipment, buildings and facilities as directed. Employee responds to Airport Rescue and fire Fighting (ARFF) situations.

May also perform Fixed Base Operator (FBO) services as necessary.

Duties:

Assists with the maintenance and repair of Airport buildings, grounds, equipment and facilities.

Assists with the maintenance of paved and unpaved areas of the Airport by mowing, rolling, sweeping, snow-plowing, snow-blowing and general housekeeping tasks.

Assists with the installation and maintenance of lighting, plumbing, electrical, HVAC systems and security systems.

Operates and Maintains Airport equipment such as motor vehicles, farm tractors, snow-plows, snow-blowers, sander, mower, weed eater, chain saw, fuel tanks and other power equipment.

Performs FBO services such as aircraft refueling, aircraft de-icing, aircraft towing, and aircraft directing.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS

High school graduate or equivalent.

Ability to lift objects, with assistance, weighing as much as 100 pounds.

Possession of a valid driver's license.

Two (2) years' experience in general construction, farming or equivalent.
