“Shooting”

Update to news release dated March 29, 2016

On March 29, 2016 at approximately 0145 hours, Officers from the Morgantown Police Department and the Monongalia County Sheriff’s Department responded to WVU Hospital for a patient who had arrived at the hospital with a gunshot wound. It was determined that the incident had occurred in the Sabraton are of Morgantown. The incident had been determined to be an isolated incident and the victim was being treated for a single gunshot wound and the injuries were non-life threatening.

Further investigation revealed that the shooting incident occurred while in a parked vehicle in an isolated area along the side of Eljadid Street in Morgantown. The investigation also revealed that the incident was an accidental self-inflicted gunshot wound. The victim, Betty Jo Strosnider, 32 year old Monongalia County resident, is currently being treated at WVU Hospital and no criminal charges are anticipated.
