NEW SINGLE-STREAM RECYCLING PROGRAM

Recycle more - it's easy! Head straight for the green recycling cart provided by Republic Services - there is no need to presort items or place them in plastic bags (except shredded paper, which should be placed in a CLEAR plastic bag). Make sure the cart lid will close, and roll the cart to the curb on recycling day for convenient service.

Recyclables are collected from green roll-out recycling carts on regular trash collection days every week.

Placement of Cart: Your cart should be placed at the curb the night before your collection day and should be placed within 3 feet of the curb or street. Do **NOT** set your cart closer than **4 feet to any obstructions** such as your trash containers (bags or cans), mailboxes, utility poles, fire hydrants, parked cars, etc. We highly recommend placing your recycling cart and trash containers in separate locations away from each other. For example, place your trash on one side of your driveway and the recycling on the opposite side of the driveway. All recycling material must be inside the cart including cardboard.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plastic Nos. 1 through 7 (Check the number inside the triangle, located on the bottom of the plastic item) • Aluminum Cans (Please rinse out cans) • Steel and bi-metal cans (Please rinse out cans) • Glass (clear, amber, and green) • Chipboard (pasta and cereal boxes, tissue boxes, paper towel rolls, etc.) • Junk mail • Magazines/Catalogs • Paperback books • Hardcover books (hardcover must be removed) • Office Paper, Shredded Paper • Phone Books • Newspapers and Newspaper Inserts • <u>Corrugated Cardboard (Boxes must be flattened/cut to fit inside cart...not wedged)</u> • Clean pizza box <u>tops</u>. • Milk or Juice Cartons with Gable Tops (Most are opened by pushing open the gables at the top, such as a small container of creamer or milk.) • Juice/Soy Milk Boxes (Aseptic Containers) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Garbage, food waste • Diapers • Paper Plates • Hangers • Meat or Cheese plastic wrapping or paper packaging • Wax or plastic wrap or bags • Freezer food packaging • Plastic deli, product or take-out packaging or utensils • Plastic bags or wrapping film • Ceramics • Mirrors • Wax-coated paper products e.g. milk cartons • Aluminum pie plates and foil • Plastic toys • Dishes, pots, and pans • Window or sheet glass • Wrapping paper • Styrofoam (pellets and formed) • Bubble Wrap • Christmas Lights • Fluorescent Light Tubes, CFL bulbs, light bulbs • Batteries of any kind • Scrap metal • Tires • Garden Hoses • Chemicals, Oil, and Paint
