Minutes Thursday, February 27, 2025

The meeting was called to order by John Trumble at 6:00 pm at the Woodburn Community Complex. Danielle made a motion to amend the previous meetings minutes to include the city workers in attendance, with a second by Shelley. All agreed. John said he would have those added.

Introductions: Lauren interviewed with city council for the last vacant spot on commission and was just waiting for approval. New Business:

- There have been frequent leaks in the roof
 - Danielle made a motion for the commission to write a letter on behalf of the tenants to ask for a temporary fix/patch to address the frequent leaks until the roof is updated.
 - Shelley seconds, all in favor
- **Comments from current tenants:**
 - The hub is forming a girl scout troop. As a service project the girls would like to clean up the flower beds around the building. The girls will come to a meeting to propose the project.
 - The hub would like to hang a TV. Looking into if they are allowed to do that or if a city worker would need to install it.
 - Aaron would love to stay where he is. He'd be interested in a more permanent type leasing agreement.
