

April 27, 2021, General Municipal Election

Monday, May 3, 2021, at 10:00 a.m.

Present: Mayor Ron Dulaney, Deputy Mayor Rachel Fetty, Council Members: Bill Kawecki, Deb Bergen, and Barry Wendell as the City of Morgantown Board of Canvassers. The following persons were present to assist the Board of Canvassers: City Clerk Christine Wade, Deputy City Clerk Heather Carl, Amy Cobasky, Marvin Davis, and Richard Lockhart from Casto & Harris.

The Common Council of the City of Morgantown met in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Monday, May 3rd at 10:15 a.m. as the ex-officio board of canvassers, this being the fifth day after the election to canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election held in the City of Morgantown, West Virginia, on Tuesday, April 27, 2021.

The Board of Canvassers chose Precinct #1 to canvass.

Motion by Deputy Mayor Fetty to set the Bond amount at \$300 if anyone decides a recount. Motion carried by consensus.

Spoiled Ballot, Christine Wade, City Clerk, announced there were none casted the day of election.

Provisional Ballots were opened by City Clerk, Christine Wade as Heather Carl, Deputy City Clerk was marking them, and the reason why a provisional was done. Once that was complete, the Board motioned to accept and count 1 out of 6 provisional ballots.


Absentee Ballots, City Clerk, Christine Wade opened 2 that was received after election day, but before canvass started. Motion carried by consensus as the Board decided to make a motion to accept 1 absentee ballot. All were verified and found to be correct.

As the Provisionals and Absentee Ballots were counted from precinct #1 Mayor Ron Dulaney read the tape as Heather Carl, Deputy City Clerk reviewed, and then Heather Carl, read the second tape as Mayor Ron Dulaney reviewed. Amy Cobasky and Marvin Davis tallied as Christine Wade, City Clerk and Deb Bergen third ward Councilor watched and reviewed. Motion by Deputy Mayor Rachel Fetty, second by Mayor Ron Dulaney, to approve the count from Precinct #1. The total votes after canvassing were 1,519.

Having completed the canvass of ballots cast for April 27, 2021, General Municipal Election, the final results were declared and upon motion by Deputy Mayor Rachel Fetty, dully seconded by Councilor Kawecki. Motion by Councilor Wendell, second by Councilor Bergen, to adjourn at 12:10 p.m.






