

**A RESOLUTION REQUIRING MASKS FOR PUBLIC MEETINGS
OF MORGANTOWN CITY COUNCIL, BOARDS, AND COMMISSIONS**

The City of Morgantown hereby resolves that, in order to protect the public health during the current surge in COVID-19 infections among the community, all participants and attendees of all public, in-person meetings of the Morgantown City Council and the boards and commissions established by the City of Morgantown shall wear a face covering at all times that covers the nose and mouth and is designed to limit the airborne spread of disease, subject to the following exceptions: children under the age of two years old; and, with the consent of the presiding officer and a majority of the members of the public body present at the meeting, any person who is addressing the public body and believes that removing the face covering is necessary to ensure adequate communication. Each public body holding meetings subject to the face covering requirement shall make reasonable accommodations for any disability that limits a person's ability to comply with the face covering requirement, and such reasonable accommodations shall allow the person access to the public meeting on substantially the same terms as those who are able to comply with the face covering requirement.
