RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR A
TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVE PROGRAM GRANT

The City Council of the City of Morgantown hereby resolves that the City Manager, or designee, is authorized to submit application for a grant or grants offered by the Department of Transportation, Transportation Alternative Program (“TAP”) grants, in the approximate amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) for design of reconfiguration of Mineral Ave and Deckers Creek Boulevard with Powell Avenue, and improvements incidental thereto, and that the City Manager or designee may also submit on behalf of the City of Morgantown any and all such other documents or necessary or helpful to the submission and processing of such application.

RECONFIGURATION OF MINERAL STREET/DECKERS CREEK BLVD AND POWELL AVE INTERSECTION

The 2022 Tap Design Grant Application consists of Improving multimodal, and specifically pedestrian, safety at the Mineral / Deckers Creek Blvd intersection with Powell Avenue has been identified as a Tier 1 priority in our region's most recent TIP + Interim Year 2030 Projects. More than two dozen recent (< 3 years) crash records in our system, including our area's only bicycle fatality in the past two decades, indicate a potential need for a broader scope of improvements. This design grant would explore comprehensive upgrades for all transportation users at this intersection including, but not limited to intersection realignments, operational upgrades, and pedestrian, cycling, and transit user facilities.
