**CONTINUATION FOR WALNUT STREET STREETScape PROJECT**

This project will be additional funding for the continuation of the Walnut Street Streetscape Project which will consist of sidewalk upgrades, ADA accessibility, complete streets development in harmony with existing project. (Prior Award 2014)
