RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR A
TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVE PROGRAM GRANT

The City Council of the City of Morgantown hereby resolves that the City Manager, or designee, is authorized to submit application for a grant or grants offered by the Department of Transportation, Transportation Alternative Program (“TAP”) grants, in the approximate amount of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) for the Airport Complete Sidewalk Streetscape Project including construction of sidewalks from the new Mileground Road Upgrades, up to the terminal, which will include ADA accessibility, electrical conduits, and lighting, and improvements incidental thereto, and that the City Manager or designee may also submit on behalf of the City of Morgantown any and all such other documents or necessary or helpful to the submission and processing of such application.

MORGANTOWN MUNICIPAL AIRPORT SIDEWALK STREETScape CONSTRUCTION

The 2022 TAP Grant application will be the construction of a streetscape project (**TAP Design Awarded in 2020**) from the Mileground to the terminal to include ADA accessibility, electrical conduits, sidewalks, and lighting. This will benefit the upgrades to the airport runway extension which will allow for more commercial flights and bigger planes to fly into Hart Field and will lead to an access of the proposed industrial park to be constructed within the parameters of the airport.
