A WALK THROUGH MORGANTOWN'S MURALS



Location: Pleasant St.

The cardinal mural, created in 2019 by artist Malissa Goff Baker represents the beauty of the WV state bird. It can be found on the side of the old Mountain Co Op building.

The side of the Health Right building highlights four local leaders' contributions to the community with a mural tribute named "Ways of Caring" created in 2019 by multiple volunteers who worked on the piece.

Location: 918 Fortney St.

Located in the Woodburn community the "Little Explorers" mural painted by Nichole Westfall was created in 2022. It was created with a grant for youth engagement.

The Landscape mural, created in 2022 by artist Eddie Spaghetti features a Red-winged Blackbird and Allegheny Mountains. It can be seen on the side of the Hughart's Supply building along the rail trail.

In addition to the Landscape mural is a circle with ferns. The mural was sponsored by the Mon River Trails Conservancy.

Location: Corner of High & Fayette St.

"Golden Wind", created by artist Bernie Wilke in 2022 symbolizes diverse people following their passions. It can be found on the side of Bubble Fish.

Located on the side of Andrew White Guitars the "Birth of a Song" mural was created in 2023 by artist Jamie Lester. It represents the child in every one of us. This is one of the largest murals in Morgantown.

Location: 198 Foundry St.



"Trusting the Mystery", which is located right next to the "Golden Wind" mural was also created in 2022 but by artist Ali Williams. It explores the interconnectedness of life and nature.

Location: 231 Spruce St.

"Steppin' Out Too" created by Brian Pickens in 2021 is located on the side of The Apothocary. It was inspired by/a tribute to a former mural in Morgantown by Butch Lee.



The "Old Town" mural is one of the oldest murals in Morgantown dating back to the 1970's. This mural, artist is unknown. Located on the side of Happy's Pub.

Location: Underside Westover Bridge

"Whirlwinds" is an abstract landscape piece on both sides of the base and was created by artist Ann Tarantino in 2022, taking both natural and man made elements within our city. It is suppose to represent feelings of energy and positivity.

Artist Elijah Pollard created the mural featuring social activist Harriet Tubman in 2022. Inspired by the former 1980s Underground Railroad bar across the street 123 Pleasant Street. This was part of a 3 piece beautification project.

Location: Alley on Court St.

Hiding in an alley on Court St., which connects High and Spruce St. across from the courthouse this mural was created in 2019. This murals, artist is unknown.

Another mural by artist Eddie Spaghetti, the colorful scene is located on the side of the Clip Joint Barber Shop. It was created in 2021 as part of a campaign to broaden the arts in Morgantown.
